

MODERN DAY SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Futamura Chemical UK Ltd is a manufacturer and supplier of speciality films and relies upon a complex global supply chain encompassing raw materials, goods and services. Our suppliers are a key element of our success and we consider it essential that they understand and are able to meet our long term needs.

The Futamura World Wide Code of Conduct commits the business to adhering to the ten principles of the United Nations Global Compact, including the protection of human rights and the elimination of all forms of forced, compulsory and child labour. Consequently Futamura does not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking.

Incorporated into our supplier approval process is a review of regulatory compliance and ethical controls undertaken. Imported materials from sources outside the EU are potentially higher risk and can be subject to enhanced background checks including supplier reputation and sanctions. The level of management control required for these sources will be continually monitored.

As part of our commitment we also subscribe to and are audited by the Supplier Ethical Data Exchange (SEDEX), a not for profit membership organisation dedicated to driving improvements in responsible and ethical business practices in global supply chains.

Futamura takes responsibility for implementing these controls and will continue to provide adequate resources and training to ensure that slavery and human trafficking does not take place within the organisation and its supply chains.

This statement will be reviewed annually.
